**NLA/LCT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

**Never Attended the LCT Show? This Is Your Opportunity!** The National Limousine Association and LCT Magazine have created a scholarship program to enable new operators to attend the industry's largest convocation, the International LCT Show.

**How Do I Participate in This Program?**

This year there are two opportunities for participation:

**1) For an operator who is a member of a local/state/regional limousine association (that is a NLA member association):**

Complete this application form and send it to your association with your request for scholarship nomination. The local/state/regional association will make their nomination selection(s) from the applications submitted and forward them to the NLA office no later than December 5, 2008. Selected recipients will be notified by December 12 to make their travel plans and head to Las Vegas!

**2) For an operator who is not a local/state/regional association member because there is no association in the local/state/regional area:**

Complete this application form and send it to the NLA Scholarship Committee directly with your request for scholarship nomination for receipt by the NLA office no later than December 5, 2008. Selected recipients will be notified by December 12 to make their travel plans and head to Las Vegas!

This year ten scholarships are available in total. This includes eight for operators located in the U.S. (two per region – Northeast, Central, Southeast, West), one for an operator located in Canada, and one for an international operator (located in any country other than the U.S. and Canada).

**What Are the Qualifications for a Scholarship Applicant?**

To apply for the scholarship, you must own a limousine company that has at least one vehicle and be in business for no more than five years. Limousine service must be your primary business. You may not have attended the International LCT Show in any capacity previously. Your application must be submitted per the requirements of either the #1 or the #2 participation opportunities described above. **Note: Scholarships are not transferable. The scholarship includes one full Show registration. Additional attendees from the same company will be required to pay a registration fee in order to attend the LCT Show.**

**What Is Required of a Scholarship Recipient?**

The recipient must attend the Scholarship Orientation Meeting, the NLA Annual Meeting, the two keynote addresses, a minimum of two educational sessions each day and visit the exhibits at the Show. The recipient also must volunteer at least two hours of time to the NLA during the Show to help as requested by the NLA Scholarship Committee. In addition, the recipient must provide a written report on the experience by February 9, 2009 to the nominating local/state/regional association (if any) and the NLA Scholarship Committee.

**Scholarship recipients will receive:**

- One full Show registration (\$310 value)
- Two paid hotel nights for January 26 and 27, 2009 (\$498 value)
- One paid 2009 NLA membership for recipients who are NOT currently members (\$205 + value)
- One paid year subscription to LCT Magazine (\$28 value)

***December 5, 2008 is the deadline for local/state/regional associations and for individuals (per the participation guidelines indicated above) to submit nominations to the NLA Scholarship Committee (c/o the NLA office). Nominations will not be accepted after that date. Nomination submission does not guarantee scholarship award.***
